TRAINING & TEAM MEETINGS

TRAVEL CONSIDERATIONS

- Accessing the remote villages where these clinics will be conducted may require lots of **very bumpy and cramped bus travel**.
- Certain villages and the travel to these places may not have the most **adequate plumbing or conveniences** that can be found in the States.
