KEY SERVICE

- In addition to the focus on business, you will also have opportunities to serve in a very hands-on way through visits to orphanages, schools, and individual elders in the community. A highlight of the trip is the water-truck day(s), in which we help to distribute thousands of gallons of water to the people of Cite Soleil (the poorest slum in the western hemisphere, if not the world).

- You will experience the sights, sounds, and smells of Haiti while meeting the vital needs of the Haitian people.
