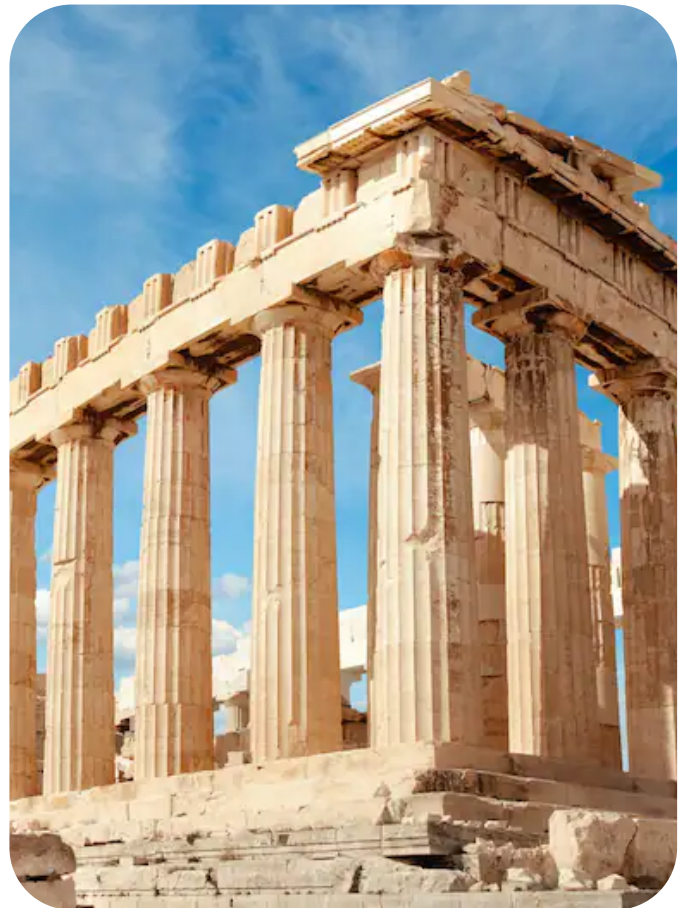


ITINERARY DISCLAIMER
