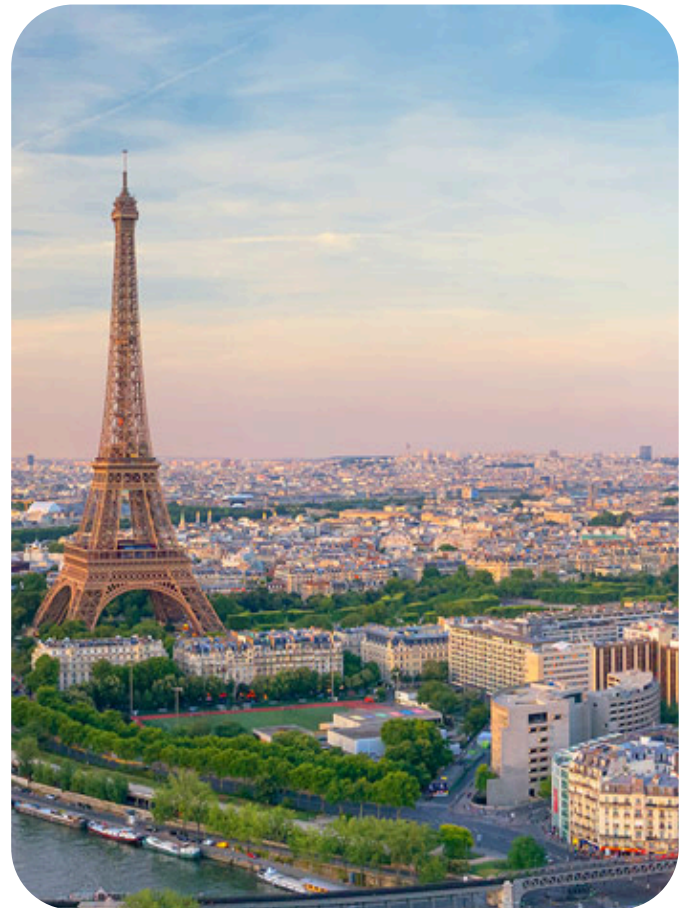


ITINERARY DISCLAIMER
