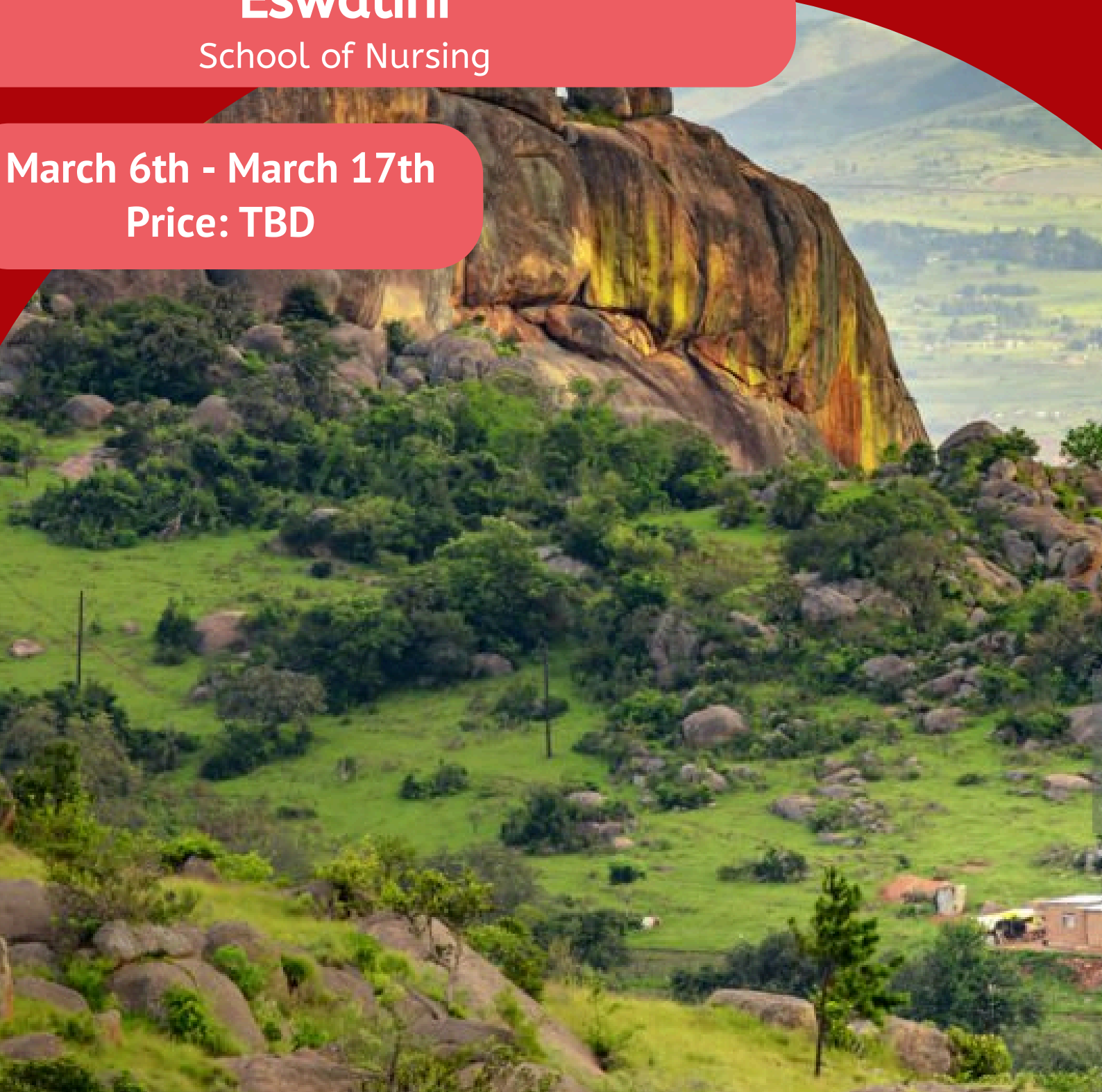

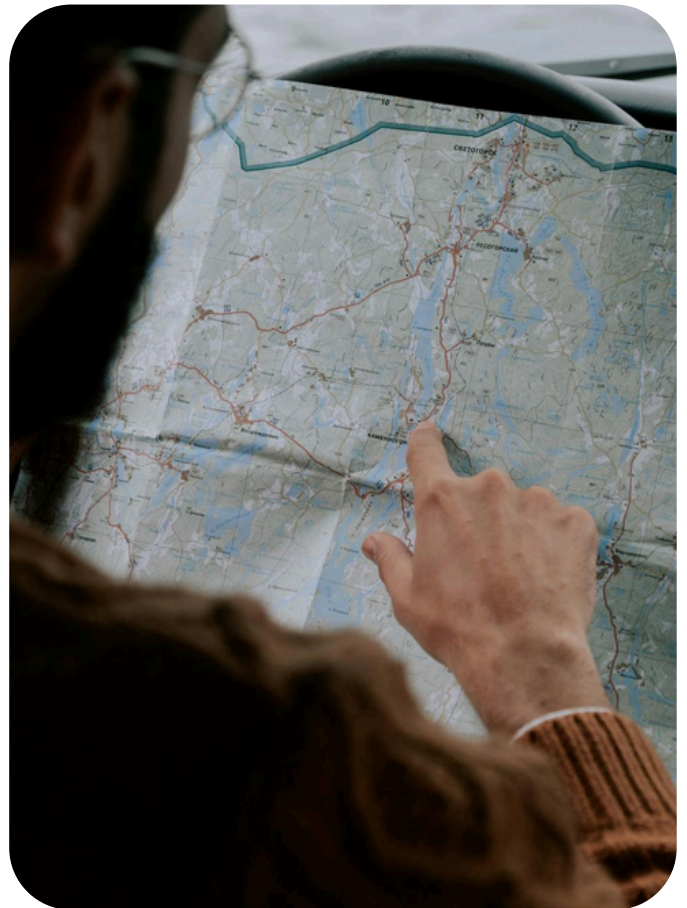


ITINERARY DISCLAIMER
