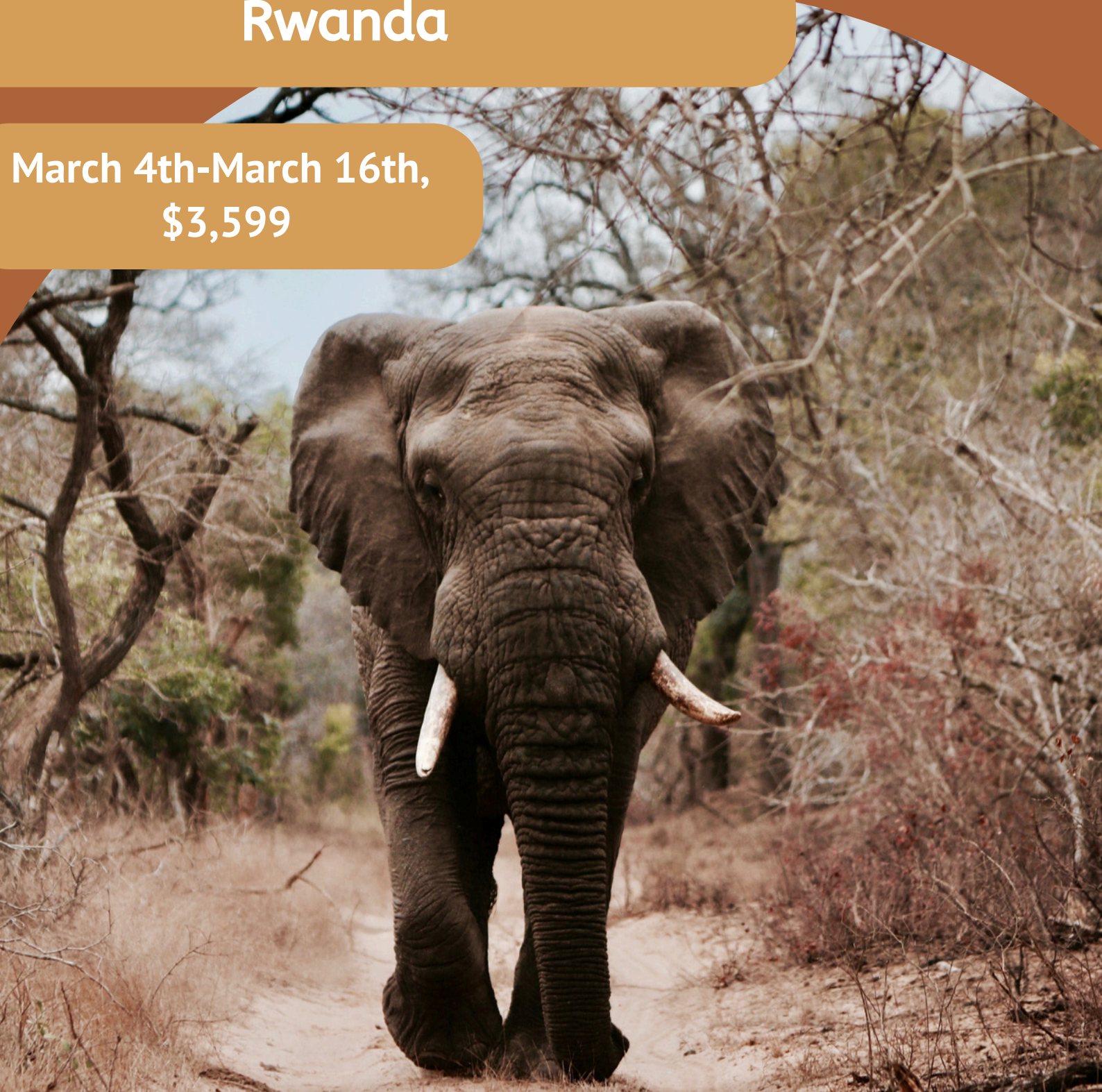

Through LU Send, this class will travel to Rwanda over Spring Break, 2025 to be educated on the historical trauma experienced by the Rwandan people through genocide will occur along with opportunities to learn about current peacebuilding and reconciliation practices, leadership development, and micro-finance support among the Rwanda population.
