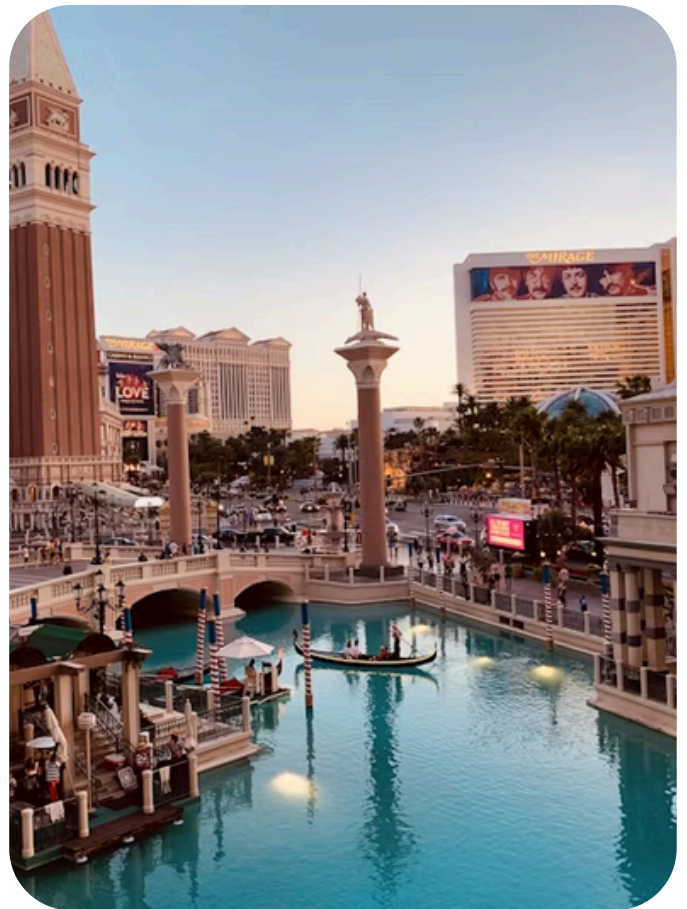
## COURSE & CULTURAL ENGAGEMENT

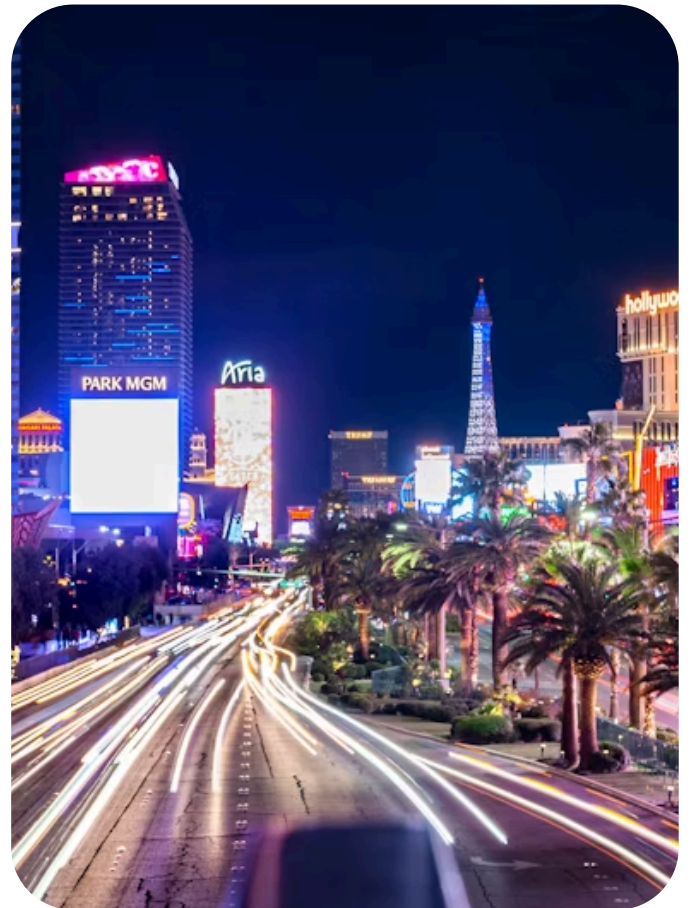


## ITINERARY DISCLAIMER
